News from Wellington Fire Protection District

Our ISO Public Protection Classification has Improved!

Through the continual support of our community, the Wellington Fire Protection District (WFPD) is proud to announce the improvement of our ISO Public Protection Classification (PPC).

- PPC Rating of 3/10: This rating applies to all Wellington residents and businesses within five road miles of a WFPD fire station AND have access to a municipal water source.
- PPC Rating of 5/10: This rating applies to all Wellington residents and business owners within five road miles of a WFPD fire station BUT have no municipal water source.



What this could mean for you:

Most insurance companies in the U.S. use the ISO's Public Protection Classification when determining the pricing of property insurance. With this new classification, you may see a reduction in your home or business insurance premium. We encourage you to contact your insurance provider to see if the WFPD's new classification will affect your policy.

Mosquito Control in The Town of Wellington is done periodically (*about once a month*) throughout the warmer months. The town will notify residents by posting a spray notice at town hall, the library, post office and on our website a day or 2 in advance. However, when we spray is always contingent upon what the weather is doing at the time, and you know if you have lived in Wellington awhile the weather can change rapidly. The towns spraying plan could change with the wind, so to speak. Spraying starts around dusk or between 8:00 pm and 9:00 pm. Good common sense should be used on evenings when spraying is planned, don't hang around outside when spraying is being done. You will see a small pickup with a blinking yellow light on top, and they do their best to stop the sprayer if they see humans or animals in the spray path. Please do your part in controlling the mosquito population, by eliminating standing water, keeping grass and weeds down, and yard debris to a minimum. Thank you.
