## Watering Guidelines

1. Watering should be limited to only that which is necessary to keep lawns and other landscape plants alive and healthy.
2. Sprinkler systems should be maintained and adjusted to prevent water running off the lawn and into the street gutter.
3. After rainstorms, turn off automatic watering systems until lawns start to dry again.
4. If cars are washed outdoors at home, washing should be done with buckets and rinsed by hose with a spray nozzle
5. Avoid letting water run.

## MANDATORY WATER RESTRICTIONS

During July through September, lawn irrigation **triples** the amount of water consumed by Wellington households and businesses. Last year, peak Summer demand reached 85% of the Town's treatment capacity, and the Town is already seeing higher demands in 2018. The restrictions are intended to reduce demand during peak hours and limit lawn sprinkling to nighttime hours which will reduce evaporative loss and thus conserve the Town's drinking water supply.

**Effectively immediately** and running through **October 15, 2018** outdoor watering using the treated water supply of the Town of Wellington (Utility Water) is restricted as follows:

**Automated sprinkling systems** are restricted to the hours between **10 PM and 6 AM**.

**Manual watering systems** are restricted to the hours between **5 PM and 10 AM**.

**Odd numbered addresses** may only water lawns on **Mon.- Wed.- Sat.**

**Even numbered addresses** may only water lawns on **Tue.- Thur.- Sun.**

For extenuating circumstances such as; new sod or landscaping that has recently been installed. **Please contact the town at 970-568-3381**

If irrigating using **adjudicated water wells**, the well owner or HOA shall at all times when water is being applied, conspicuously **post the property** as being watered using "**well water**" or "**non-potable water.**"
