### It's Snow Season, here's what you need to know:

**Snow Plowing** is done by the Town's Public Works Department.

**1<sup>st</sup> priority** – Schools, High traffic streets for example; Washington, Jefferson, Sixth, Hwy. 1 etc.

**2<sup>nd</sup> priority** – Third, Kitfox, Buffalo Creek Parkway etc.

**Residential streets**- one pass will be done after all high traffic streets are cleared.

Cleveland Avenue is plowed by Colorado Department of Transportation. (CDOT)

#### Attention:

#### Private Snow Plow Operators

**You are not allowed to pile the snow that you have cleared on to any town street. All snow must be stored on your own property.**

### GET READY FOR WINTER

#### Underground Sprinkler Systems –

Avoid costly repairs have your backflow preventer and sprinkler lines, blown out before the first freeze.

#### Sidewalks – Snow

and Ice must be cleared within 24 hours, after the snow stops falling.

**Do not** shovel your snow from your property into the street or gutter. Citations will be issued.

### Help First Responders locate your home faster.

Please put your Address Numbers on your House. Address numbers should be 4" high by ½" thick and visible from the street.

**Meter Pits**- Help us avoid estimating your water bill. Please keep your meter pit uncovered and clear of snow and debris.
