It's Snow Season, here's what you need to know:

Snow Plowing is done by the Town's Public Works Department.

1st priority – Schools, High traffic streets for example; Washington, Jefferson, Sixth, Hwy. 1 etc.

2nd priority – Third, Kitfox, Buffalo Creek Parkway etc.

Residential streets- one pass will be done after all high traffic streets are cleared.

Cleveland Avenue is plowed by Colorado Department of Transportation. (CDOT)

You are not allowed to pile the snow that you have cleared on to any town street. All snow must be stored on your own property.

GET READY FOR WINTER

Sidewalks – Snow and Ice must be cleared within 24 hours, after the snow stops falling. Do not shovel your snow from your property into the street or gutter. Citations will be issued.

Help First Responders locate your home faster.

Please put your Address Numbers on your House. Address numbers should be 4" high by 1/2" thick and visible from the street.

Meter Pits- Help us avoid estimating your water bill. Please keep your meter pit uncovered and clear of snow and debris.

Change can be a good thing; and in this case a great thing! I attended an AspenCat Users Group meeting and there are some great changes coming in the new year. In February, AspenCat will begin using Bywater as its new system. What that means for the library is that our system will be easier to use with less times when the system is down. Searching for books on the new system will be easier and tracking books will be easier. Patrons will probably notice an improvement in finding items on the online catalog.

So, your first question is probably what is AspenCat? AspenCat is a union-catalog, integrated library system. There are currently over 100 AspenCat member libraries, including public, school, academic and special libraries.

As a Wellington Public Library Patron, you have easy access to over one million items in the AspenCat Catalog. You can browse the AspenCat Catalog online, and with your library card number you can place items on hold. If the item is in our library, we will pull the item and have it waiting for you. If the item is coming from another library, it will be sent to the WPL for you to retrieve. If you have not used our system, we encourage you to do so, and with the changes that are coming, you will definitely want to see what is available to you.
